

**RANDY WENTZEL, GLEN OAKS MOBILE HOME PARK WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY, Placer County**

The Discharger owns and operates a wastewater treatment facility (WWTF) which serves the needs of Glen Oaks Mobile Home Park. The WWTF serves 33 mobile homes, nine cabins, one duplex, and one laundry facility, and consists of approximately 1,200 feet of collection system piping, three concrete septic tanks, two wastewater holding tanks, and an evaporation/percolation pond. The evaporation/percolation pond has a storage capacity of approximately 467,000 gallons at two feet of freeboard. These WDRs allow for a monthly average dry weather discharge not to exceed 6,800 gallons per day, and require the Discharger to restrict public access to the pond, install a flow meter, install and sample groundwater monitoring wells, and prepare an operations and maintenance plan. Surface water drainage from the site is to an unnamed tributary to the North Fork of the American River. (GJC)
