## **COMMENTS ON 19 JANUARY 2011 SEDIMENT CONTROL PLAN FOR PARCEL NUMBER 016-008-015, STANISLAUS COUNTY**

Thank you for your updated submittal of the Sediment Control Plan (Plan) for Assessors Parcel Number 011-110-026 (parcel), which you provided in response to the Notice of Violation (NOV) sent to you on 31 August 2010. Pursuant to the NOV, the Plan was to describe new management practices to prevent discharges of sediment from the parcel, as well as a schedule for implementing these practices.

California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Central Valley Water Board) staff has reviewed the Plan and found that it meets the NOV's requirements for a technical report. Water Board staff urges you to promptly implement your planned sediment control management practices, and to regularly inspect irrigation return flows and storm water runoff from your property to ensure that these practices are effective.

You should be aware that Central Valley Water Board staff may inspect the area surrounding your property to verify that any storm water or irrigation discharges do not contain sediment in amounts that cause nuisance or violate applicable water quality objectives.
