Title of Topic:	Background	45 min
Background:	In the Delta Stewardship Council's Delta Plan , the Water Board was directed to prepare and begin implementing a study plan to develop nutrient objectives for the Delta and Suisun Marsh. This is Water Quality Recommendation #8 in Chapter 6 of the Delta Plan. Central Valley Regional Water Board staff wrote a Strategic Work Plan that includes tasks, deliverables and a timeline to develop the study plan and determine if nutrient objectives are necessary.	
Desired Outcome	Shared understanding of why this effort is starting, what the initial products will be, and the timeline.

Title of Topic:	Three Topic-Specific White Papers	120 min+15 min break
Background:	In an effort to gather necessary information to develop the Nutrient Study Plan, the Water Board is contracting with experts to develop white papers on two of the three major topics outlined in the Delta Plan: <i>macrophytes</i> and <i>harmful algal blooms</i> . These white papers will include a review of the current literature, with an emphasis on nutrients, and identification of data gaps. Kathy Boyer, from the Romberg Tiburon Center, has been commissioned to write the white paper on macrophytes, and Mine Berg, from Applied Marine Sciences, has been commissioned to write the white paper on harmful algal blooms. Mine's outline is provided here for review, and we hope to have Kathy's shortly before the meeting. The group will discuss how to go about synthesizing the information and producing a white paper on the effect of nutrient forms, concentrations and ratios on algal species composition.	
Desired Outcome	Identify interested parties for each sub-topic and discuss follow-up meetings. Discussion on what available information should be included in each white paper. Recruitment or identification of others that should be included for these discussions.
