

6. The groundwaters in the local area are saline and are not beneficially used.
7. The Board has notified the discharger and interested agencies and persons of its intent to prescribe waste discharge requirements for the discharge.


The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

1. The Regents of the University of California (hereinafter also referred to as the discharger), 1004 E. Holton Road, El Centro, California 92243, submitted a Report of Waste Discharge dated May 13, 1977.
2. The discharger proposes to discharge an average of 7,000 gallons-per-day of domestic sewage, from residences and facilities of an agricultural field station, through a septic tank/leach field system. The discharge site is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 32, T15S, R15E, SBB&M.
3. The discharger reports that the leach field system is designed to have five fields working while one is resting. Each 100 foot long field has four lines with a seepage pit (3' dia. x 8' deep) at the end of each line. This system would allow at least two months of rest for each field every year. The discharger has also reserved areas of sufficient size for 100% replacement of the disposal field. These areas are designated on Attachment "A" incorporated herein and made a part of this Order.
4. The discharge is presently governed by Waste Discharge Requirements contained in Order No. 77-32 (NPDES Permit No. CA0104795) for discharge into South Central Drain No. 1.
5. The Water Quality Control Plan for the West Colorado River Basin was adopted by the Board on April 10, 1975. The Basin Plan contains water quality objectives for Imperial


B. Provisions

1. The areas reserved for 100% replacement of the subsurface disposal fields, as shown on Attachment A, shall at all times be retained servient to this field station, for the purpose of providing additional subsurface sewage disposal capacity, until such time as this station is connected to a municipal sewerage system.
2. Upon request from this Board's Executive Officer, the discharger shall furnish technical and/or monitoring reports on the treatment and discharge of waste.
3. Prior to any modifications in this facility which would result in material change in the quality or quantity of wastewater discharged, or any material change in location of discharge, the discharger shall report in writing to the Regional Board.
4. Prior to any proposed change in operation, or in control or ownership of the land upon which the discharge facilities are located, the discharger shall report in writing to the Regional Board.
5. Prior to any future sale of this field station, the discharger shall:
  - a. Specify as a condition of sale that said sewage disposal site must remain servient to the station for the purpose of providing additional subsurface sewage disposal capacity, until such time as this field station is connected to a municipal sewerage system.
  - b. Notify the succeeding owner, in writing, of the existence of this Order, and forward a copy of said correspondence to the Regional Board.
6. This Order supersedes Board Order No. 77-32.


