RESCISSION OF CEASE AND DESIST ORDER
NO. 78-73 AGAINST THE MT. SAN JACINTO
WINTER PARK AUTHORITY AND
CEASE AND DESIST ORDER NO. 77-78
AGAINST UNIVERSAL PROCESSORS, INC.


The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

1. The Mt. San Jacinto Winter Park Authority has constructed additional wastewater treatment and disposal facilities, and adopted water conservation procedures which have resolved the water quality control problems which necessitated the adoption of Cease and Desist Order No. 78-73.
2. Universal Processors, Inc., has ceased the processing of carrots, thereby eliminating the wastewater discharge which necessitated the adoption of Cease and Desist Order No. 77-78.
3. Enforcement actions as specified in Cease and Desist Orders No. 78-73 and 77-78 are no longer required.
4. The Board forwarded timely notice by mail to the dischargers and to all other affected persons and agencies, explaining its intent to rescind Cease and Desist Orders No. 78-73 and 77-78.
5. The Board in a public meeting heard and considered all comments pertaining to the rescission of Cease and Desist Orders No. 78-73 and 77-78.
6. This enforcement action is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code, Section 21000, et. seq) in accordance with Section 15121, Chapter 3, Title 14, California Administrative Code.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Cease and Desist Order No. 78-73 is hereby rescinded.
2. Cease and Desist Order No. 77-78 is hereby rescinded.
