RESCISSION OF

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

1. The below listed Board Orders contain waste discharge requirements for wastewater disposal facilities that are no longer in use, or are Change of Name and/or Ownership Orders pertaining to facilities for which requirements have been either rescinded or updated.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, the following Orders containing waste discharge requirements are rescinded:


