
RESOLUTION 99-057

CONCLUSION OF THE 1999 TRIENNIAL REVIEW OF THE  
WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR THE COLORADO RIVER BASIN REGION

- WHEREAS, Section 303(c) of the Federal Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C.A. 1313(c), requires that water quality standards be reviewed, and revised if appropriate, on at minimum a triennial basis, and Section 13240 of the California Water Code provides that Water Quality Control Plans (Basin Plans) be periodically reviewed and may be revised; and
- WHEREAS, The Federal Clean Water Act requires that each state prepare water quality control plans for all basin planning areas within the State; and
- WHEREAS, The 1994 Water Quality Control Plan for the Colorado River Basin Region was reviewed pursuant to State law and in accordance with the State Water Resources Control Board's Basin Plan Update Administrative Procedures and State Law. This triennial review process satisfies the federal triennial review requirements of Section 303(c) of the Clean Water Act and the periodic review requirements of Water Code Section; and
- WHEREAS, The Regional Board prepared and circulated the draft Triennial Review List and associated staff reports to interested parties; and
- WHEREAS, The Regional Board conducted a Basin Plan Triennial Review public workshop on March 11, 1999 in Indian Wells after giving due notice to all interested persons in accordance with applicable provisions of the Federal Clean Water Act and Division 7 of the California Water Code; and
- WHEREAS, The Regional Board conducted a public hearing on June 10, 1999 in Indian Wells after giving due notice to all interested persons in accordance with applicable provisions of the Federal Clean Water Act and Division 7 of the California Water Code; and
- WHEREAS, The Regional Board has considered evidence introduced at said public workshop and hearing, and also as received during the public comment period; and
- WHEREAS, The Regional Board has responded to all comments; and
- WHEREAS, The Water Quality Control Plan includes all necessary elements of a water quality control plan in accordance with State and Federal requirements; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region hereby adopts the 1999 Triennial Review List, identifying issues in need of investigation and possible revision; and be it further

- RESOLVED, That the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region hereby reaffirms those areas of the 1994 Water Quality Control Plan for the Colorado River Basin Region that were not identified as needing investigation and possible revision; and be it further
- RESOLVED, That the Regional Board's Executive Officer is directed to prepare workplans for each of the issues on the Triennial Review List; and be it further
- RESOLVED, That the Regional Board's Executive Officer is directed to forward the Administrative Record of this 1999 Triennial Review for the Colorado River Basin Region of California to the State Water Resources Control Board for consideration of approval.
