ORDER R7-2013-0065

**RESCISSION OF
WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

1. For the reasons stated below, it is desirable to rescind said below-listed Board Orders.
2. The Board timely forwarded notices by mail to persons responsible for the below-listed Board Orders explaining the Board's consideration of rescinding the particular Board Orders, and requesting comments.
3. The Board, in a public meeting, heard and considered all comments pertaining to the proposed rescission of the below-listed Board Orders.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, the following Board Orders, containing Waste Discharge Requirements, be rescinded, except for enforcement purposes.

99-061	Mine Reclamation Corporation Eagle Mountain Class III, Desert Center	September 16, 1999

The Discharger notified staff by letter dated June 28, 2013, that it will no longer be pursuing the Eagle Mountain Landfill Project as currently permitted in Board Order 99-061. The Discharger explained that it made this decision after the Los Angeles County Sanitation Districts announced on May 22, 2013, that it would no longer be pursuing the subject project to consider acquisition of the Project property for use by the Districts as a landfill. Accordingly, the Discharger has requested that its permit be terminated.

R7-2009-0053	Ormat Nevada, Inc. Wister Geothermal Exploration	May 21, 2009
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No work was ever completed at this project. A new WDR (R7-2011-0053 Highline Geothermal Exploration Project will include the previous Wister Project wells.
