ORDER R7-2015-0027

**RESCISSION OF
WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

1. For the reasons stated below, it is desirable to rescind said below-listed Board Orders.
2. The Board timely forwarded notices by mail to persons responsible for the below-listed Board Orders explaining the Board's consideration of rescinding the particular Board Orders, and requesting comments.
3. The Board, in a public meeting, heard and considered all comments pertaining to the proposed rescission of the below-listed Board Orders.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, the following Board Orders, containing Waste Discharge Requirements, be rescinded, except for enforcement purposes.

85-016	Havasu Palms Mobile Home and RV Park Landfill for Nonhazardous Waste Class II Lake Havasu - San Bernardino County	January 23, 1985

Reason for Rescission: The discharge is located on the Chemehuevi Reservation and the Colorado River Basin Water Board does not have jurisdiction to regulate discharges on tribal lands.

88-056	Farm Air Service Commercial Pesticide Application Operation Calipatria - Imperial County	March 23, 1988

Reason for Rescission: In September 1991, Colorado River Basin Water Board staff verified the closure of the Discharger's surface impoundment at the Calipatria Municipal Airport as required by the Board. The impoundment was properly leveled and the monitoring wells were properly destroyed.
