

Whereas, on the 5th day of August, 1915 one
DATE REC'D 8/20/25 ASSIGNMENT TO George Fusenot
of the County of Los Angeles, State of
California, duly made application No. 98 to the State Water Commission,

(formerly the Board of Control, Water Power) of the State of California, for a permit to use the waters of
Wards Canyon and Oak Canyon, in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, for the purpose of agricultural and domestic uses

Whereas, on the 9th day of February, 1916
a permit was issued to said applicant for the diversion of said water for the term of seven months, and

Whereas, a favorable report was made upon the said project by the Engineer for the said Water Commission, on the 6th day of October, 1916 whereupon said Water Commission became satisfied of the right of the said applicant to a license for the use of the said waters of the said Wards Canyon and Oak Canyon.

Now, Therefore, by virtue of the authority vested in the said Water Commission by the laws of the State of California, we do hereby grant and confirm to the said Georges Fusenot of the City and County of Los Angeles the holder and owner of said permit hereinabove mentioned, for the period of 3/40 years from the date of this license, the use of 3/40 cubic feet per second of the waters of Oak Canyon, cubic feet per second of the waters of Wards Canyon and in the county of Los Angeles, State of California, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purposes hereinbelow mentioned; said water to be diverted from points as follows: Wards Canyon #1 at a point which bears S. 88° 26' 45" E., 8990' from the NW corner of Sec. 20; Wards Canyon #2 at a point which bears S. 78° 41' 15" E., 7802' from the NW corner of Sec. 20; and from Oak Canyon at a point which bears S. 79° 50' E., 9108' from the NW corner of Sec. 20, T. 2 N., R. 13 W., S.B.M. and to be used for agricultural and domestic purposes on 40 acres of land located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec. 21, T. 2 N., R. 13 W., S.B.M.



subject to the laws of the State of California, applicable to a license for the use of the waters of the State, and subject to vested rights.
