ORDER REVOKING LICENSE


COUNTY: Siskiyou

WHEREAS:

1. A request dated July 22, 2004, has been received from the Licensee that the license be revoked by the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB), Division of Water Rights (Division).
2. The Division interprets the Licensee's request for revocation as a waiver of the notice and hearing requirements set forth in Water Code sections 1675 through 1675.2.
3. The SWRCB has found that Licensee failed to apply the water to beneficial use under the terms and conditions of this license.

THEREFORE:

It is ordered that License 1882 is hereby revoked by the SWRCB, and the water is declared to be subject to appropriation. This revocation may not result in additional water being available for new appropriations if there are applicable restrictions due to past SWRCB decisions regarding water availability.

has made proof to the satisfaction of the Division
of Water Resources of California of a right to the use of the waters of **Cole Creek in Siskiyou County**

tributary of **Klamath River via South Fork of Indian Creek and Indian Creek**

for the purpose of **mining use**

under Permit **4046** of the Division of Water Resources and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of California, the rules and regulations of the Division of Water Resources and the terms of the said permit; that the priority of the right herein confirmed dates from **August 8, 1932;**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to the amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed **one (1) cubic foot per second** from **January 1st to December 31st** of each season.

The point of diversion of such water is located **North three hundred (300) and West four hundred fifty (450) feet** from the southeast corner of **Section 10, T 17 N, R 6 E, H.B.&M.** and being within the **SE $\frac{1}{4}$** of **SE $\frac{1}{4}$** of said **Section 10**

A description of the lands or the place where such water is put to beneficial use is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of **SW $\frac{1}{4}$** of **Section 11, T 17 N, R 6 E, H.B.&M.**

Water is returned to **South Fork of Indian Creek** at the place of use.

Reports shall be filed promptly by licensee on appropriate forms which will be provided for the purpose from time to time by the Division of Water Resources.

The right to the diversion and use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the point of diversion herein specified and to the lands or place of use herein described.
