ORDER REVOKING LICENSE


SOURCE: Pleasants Creek tributary to Putah Creek

WHEREAS:

1. A Report of Licensee for 2002, 2003, 2004 dated March 21, 2005 has been received from M.J. Hudson (Licensee), requesting revocation of the license by the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights (Division).
2. The Division interprets the Licensee's request for revocation as a waiver of the notice and hearing requirements set forth in Water Code sections 1675 through 1675.2.

Therefore, it is ordered that License 2452 is hereby revoked by the State Water Board, and the water is declared to be subject to appropriation. This revocation may not result in additional water being available for new appropriations if there are applicable restrictions due to past State Water Board decisions regarding water availability.

has made proof to the satisfaction of the Division of Water Resources of California of a right to the use of the waters of **Pleasant (or Miller) Creek in Solano County**

tributary of **Futah Creek**

for the purpose of **irrigation use** under Permit **4901** of the Division of Water Resources and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of California, the rules and regulations of the Division of Water Resources and the terms of the said permit; that the priority of the right herein confirmed dates from **January 2, 1937;**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to the amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed **six hundredths (0.06) cubic feet per second from about April 15th to about August 1st of each season.**

The point of diversion of such water is located at any point on **Pleasant (or Miller) Creek** between a point located **East five hundred eighty (580) feet and North eighteen hundred twenty-six (1826) feet**, and a point located **West fifteen hundred twenty-two (1522) feet and North four hundred forty (440) feet** from the center of **Section 12, T 7 N, R 2 W, M.D.B.&M.**, and being within the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$ and $S\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 12.

A description of the lands or the place where such water is put to beneficial use is as follows: **Irrigation**
of **2 acres** within the $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12

All rights and privileges under this license including method of diversion, method of use and quantity of water diverted are subject to the continuing authority of the Division of Water Resources in accordance with law and in the interest of the public welfare to prevent waste, unreasonable use, unreasonable method of use or unreasonable method of diversion of said water.

Reports shall be filed promptly by licensee on appropriate forms which will be provided for the purpose from time to time by the Division of Water Resources.

The right to the diversion and use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the point of diversion herein specified and to the lands or place of use herein described.
