ORDER ALLOWING CORRECTION OF DESCRIPTION  
OF SOURCE

WHEREAS License 2829 was issued to Crescent Bay Council, Boy Scouts of America, and was filed with the County Recorder of Kern County on April 22, 1946, and

WHEREAS said license was subsequently assigned to U. S. Los Padres National Forest, and


WHEREAS the State Water Rights Board has found that the correction of description of source under said license for which petition was submitted on May 5, 1964, will not operate to the injury of any other legal user of water, and

WHEREAS the Board has approved and allowed said correction and has directed that an order be issued to describe said source in accordance with said petition;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that permission be and the same is hereby granted to correct the description of the source under said License 2829 to read as follows, to wit:

UPPER SAN EMIGDIO SPRINGS TRIBUTARY TO SAN EMIGDIO CREEK THENCE  
BUENA VISTA LAKE.

## License for Diversion and Use of Water

LICENSE 2829

PERMIT 5950

APPLICATION 10335

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That **Crescent Bay Council, Boy Scouts of America,**  
**Santa Monica, California** Notice of Assignment (Over)

has made proof as of **August 11, 1944**

(the date of inspection) to the satisfaction of the State Engineer of California of a right to the use of the waters of

**3 unnamed springs in Kern County**

tributary to **San Emigdio Creek and Buena Vista Lake Drainage**

for the purpose of **domestic and recreational uses**  
under Permit **5950** of the Department of Public Works and that said right to the use of said waters has  
been perfected in accordance with the laws of California, the rules and regulations of the Department of Public Works  
and the terms of the said permit; that the priority of the right herein confirmed dates from **November 28, 1941;**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited  
to the amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed **twenty five thousand two**  
**hundred (25,200) gallons per day from Spring No. 1 from about May 15th to about**  
**September 15th of each season for recreational purposes; and fourteen hundred forty**  
**(1440) gallons per day combined diversion from Springs No. 2 and No. 3 from January 1st**  
**to December 31st of each season for domestic purposes.**

This license is based on the use of water made during the year 1944 which was the  
year of maximum use within the three year period immediately preceding the date of  
inspection.

The points of diversion of such water are located (1) **eighteen hundred ten (1810) feet**  
**North and twenty six hundred eighty nine (2689) feet West from the southeast corner**  
**of Section 23, T 9 N, R 21 W, S.B.B. & M., being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said**  
**Section 23; and the locus of (2) & (3) eleven hundred ninety (1190) feet North and**  
**five hundred eighty eight (588) feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 23,**  
**T 9 N, R 21 W, S.B.B. & M., being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 23.**

A description of the lands or the place where such water is put to beneficial use is as follows:

**Domestic and recreational uses at Trefoil Boy Scouts Camp within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$**   
**of Section 23, T 9 N, R 21 W, S.B. B. & M.**

All rights and privileges under this license including method of diversion, method of use and quantity of water  
diverted are subject to the continuing authority of the Department acting through the State Engineer in accordance  
with law and in the interest of the public welfare to prevent waste, unreasonable use, unreasonable method of use or  
unreasonable method of diversion of said water.

Reports shall be filed promptly by licensee on appropriate forms which will be provided for the purpose from  
time to time by the State Engineer.

The right to the diversion and use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the point of diversion  
herein specified and to the lands or place of use herein described.

*This license is granted and licensee accepts all rights herein confirmed subject to the following provisions of the Water Code:*

Section 1625. Each license shall be in such form and contain such terms as may be prescribed by the Department.

Section 1626. All licenses shall be under the terms and conditions of this division (of the Water Code).

Section 1627. A license shall be effective for such time as the water actually appropriated under it is used for a useful and beneficial purpose in conformity with this division (of the Water Code) but no longer.

Section 1628. Every license shall include the enumeration of conditions therein which in substance shall include all of the provisions of this article and the statement that any appropriator of water to whom a license is issued takes the license subject to the conditions therein expressed.

Section 1629. Every licensee, if he accepts a license, does so under the conditions precedent that no value whatsoever in excess of the actual amount paid to the State therefor shall at any time be assigned to or claimed for any license granted or issued under the provisions of this division (of the Water Code), or for any rights granted or acquired under the provisions of this division (of the Water Code), in respect to the regulation by any competent public authority of the services or the price of the services to be rendered by any licensee or by the holder of any rights granted or acquired under the provisions of this division (of the Water Code) or in respect to any valuation for purposes of sale to or purchase, whether through condemnation proceedings or otherwise, by the State or any city, city and county, municipal water district, irrigation district, lighting district, or any political subdivision of the State, of the rights and property of any licensee, or the possessor of any rights granted, issued, or acquired under the provisions of this division (of the Water Code).

Section 1630. At any time after the expiration of twenty years after the granting of a license, the State or any city, city and county, municipal water district, irrigation district, lighting district, or any political subdivision of the State shall have the right to purchase the works and property occupied and used under the license and the works built or constructed for the enjoyment of the rights granted under the license.

Section 1631. In the event that the State, or any city, city and county, municipal water district, irrigation district, lighting district, or political subdivision of the State so desiring to purchase and the owner of the works and property can not agree upon the purchase price, the price shall be determined in such manner as is now or may hereafter be provided by law for determining the value of property taken in eminent domain proceedings.
