La Paloma Creek in Los Angeles County

tributary to **Big Tujunga Canyon**

for the purpose of **domestic use**
under Permit **6077**

of the Department of Public Works and that said right to the use of said water has been perfected in accordance with the laws of California, the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Public Works and the terms of the said permit; that the priority of the right herein confirmed dates from **September 19, 1942**; and that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to the amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed **two hundred (200) gallons per day** to be diverted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.

The point of diversion of such water is located **North five hundred fifteen (515) feet and West fifteen hundred (1500) feet** from SE corner of Section 3, T 2 N, R 13 W, S.B.B.&M., being within SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 3.

A description of the lands or the place where such water is put to beneficial use is as follows: **Lot 52 of Big Tujunga Tract of Angeles National Forest, being within SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 3, T 2 N, R 13 W, S.B.B.&M.**
