ORDER REVOKING LICENSE

SOURCE: Unnamed Spring tributary to Donner Lake


COUNTY: Nevada

WHEREAS:

1. A request dated February 3, 2004 has been received from the Licensee requesting revocation of the license by the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB), Division of Water Rights (Division). Susan Keenan, current owner of the cabin served by License 3466, concurred with revocation of License 3466 during a February 24, 2004 telephone conversation with Division staff.
2. The Division interprets the Licensee's request for revocation as a waiver of the notice and hearing requirements set forth in Water Code sections 1675 through 1675.2.

THEREFORE:

It is ordered that License 3466 is hereby revoked by the SWRCB, and the water is declared to be subject to appropriation. This revocation may not result in additional water being available for new appropriations if there are applicable restrictions due to past SWRCB decisions regarding water availability.

(the date of inspection) to the satisfaction of the State Engineer of California of a right to the use of the water of
an unnamed spring in Nevada County

tributary to Donner Lake

for the purpose of domestic use
under Permit 6826 of the Department of Public Works and that said right to the use of said water has
been perfected in accordance with the laws of California, the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Public Works
and the terms of the said permit; that the priority of the right herein confirmed dates from November 20, 1946;
and that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited
to the amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed two hundred (200) gallons
per day to be diverted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

The point of diversion of such water is located North three hundred (300) feet and
West one thousand six hundred (1600) feet from the SE corner of Section 12,
T 17 N, R 15 E, M.D.B.&M., being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 12.

A description of the lands or the place where such water is put to beneficial use is as follows: Lot 48,
Donner Lake Tract, Tahoe National Forest, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of
Section 12, T 17 N, R 15 E, M.D.B.&M.
