(the date of inspection) to the satisfaction of the State Engineer of California of a right to the use of the water of an unnamed stream in Contra Costa County

tributary to Grayson Creek thence Suisun Bay

for the purpose of irrigation, domestic and stock-watering uses under Permit 6811 of the Department of Public Works and that said right to the use of said water has been perfected in accordance with the laws of California, the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Public Works and the terms of the said permit; that the priority of the right herein confirmed dates from December 6, 1946; and that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to the amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed two and four tenths (2.4) acre-feet per annum to be collected from about October 1 of each year to about May 1 of the succeeding year.

The point of diversion of such water is located south one thousand three hundred sixty (1360) feet and east sixteen thousand eight hundred eighty (16,880) feet from SW corner of Section 36, T 2 N, R 3 W, MDB&M, being within SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of projected Section 4, T 1 N, R 2 W, MDB&M.

A description of the lands or the place where such water is put to beneficial use is as follows:
domestic and stock-watering uses and irrigation of 2 acres within SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of projected Section 4, T 1 N, R 2 W, MDB&M.
