*Under the provisions of Article 2.5, Chapter 1 of Part 2 of Division 2 of the Water Code,*

*has filed a claim of water right for stockpond construction prior to January 1, 1969, and has applied to the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) for evidence of such water right.*

*It appears from evidence provided by the claimant and from such other information as has been obtained by the SWRCB that the stockpond described herein had a capacity of 10 acre-feet or less on January 1, 1975; that the stockpond was constructed prior to January 1, 1969; that the stockpond is used primarily for stockwatering purposes; and that the stockpond was not involved in water rights litigation between private parties prior to January 1, 1974.*

*Therefore, the SWRCB certifies that the above-named claimant has complied with the statute and has a water right within the meaning of Water Code Section 1226.1, to collect and hold in storage 4.0 acre-feet of water for stockwatering, including domestic and recreational use which is incidental to stockwatering use, at the following location:*

*On Unnamed Stream tributary to Sinbad Creek  
being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 6, T4S, R1E, MDB&M  
in the County of Alameda.*

*The Claimant's water right priority of this certificate is March 25, 1985, the date of filing, and is subject to all prior water rights.*
