ORDER

Application 8281 Permit 4581 License 4164

ORDER AMENDING LICENSE

WHEREAS:

1. License 4164 was issued to the United States, Inyo National Forest, and recorded at the office of the Mono County Recorder on January 4, 1956.
2. License 4164 confers upon the United States, Inyo National Forest, an appropriative right to use water from McLeod Lake in Mono County.
3. Fish and Game Code Section 5946 requires that the State Water Resources Control Board condition Licenses that authorize diversion of water in Department of Fish and Game District 4 ½ (Inyo and Mono Counties) to specify compliance with Section 5937 of the Fish and Game Code.
4. The License was issued without referencing compliance with Section 5937.
5. Since amendment of License 4164 to require compliance with Fish and Game Code Section 5937 is a ministerial action, this Order is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the State CEQA Guidelines in accordance with Section 21080 of the Public Resources Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The following condition is added to this License:

In accordance with the requirements of Fish and Game Code Section 5946, this License is conditioned upon full compliance with Section 5937 of the Fish and Game Code.

ORDER ALLOWING CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

WHEREAS:

1. License 4164 was issued to United States, Inyo National Forest and was filed with the County Recorder of Mono County on January 4, 1956.
2. A petition for change in place of use has been filed with the State Water Resources Control Board and said Board has determined that good cause for such change has been shown.
3. The Board has determined that the petitioned changes do not constitute the initiation of a new right nor operate to the injury of any other lawful user of water.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The place of use under this license shall be as follows:

Lots 1 to 9 inclusive of Lower Falls Tract, within SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9; Lots 16 to 28 inclusive of Upper Falls Tract, within NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8; and Wildyrie Resort within SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9, all being within T4S, R27E, MDB&M.

License for Diversion and Use of Water

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That

U. S. - Inyo National Forest
Bishop, California

has made proof as of September 21, 1953
(the date of inspection) to the satisfaction of the State Engineer of California of a right to the use of the water of
McLeod Lake in Mono County

tributary to Mammoth Creek thence Owens River

for the purpose of domestic, (incidental stockwatering) and fire protection purposes under Permit 4581 of the Department of Public Works and that said right to the use of said water has been perfected in accordance with the laws of California, the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Public Works and the terms of the said permit; that the priority of the right herein confirmed dates from March 11, 1935; and that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to the amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed six thousand (6000) gallons per day to be diverted from about June 1 to about October 15 of each year.

The point of diversion of such water is located north eighty-seven degrees west ($N 87^{\circ} W$) five thousand five hundred sixteen (5516) feet from SE corner of Section 8, T 4 S, R 27 E, MDB&M, being within $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of projected Section 7, T 4 S, R 27 E, MDB&M.

A description of the lands or the place where such water is put to beneficial use is as follows:

Lots 5 to 9 inclusive of Lower Falls Tract within $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9,
Lot 14 and Lots 16 to 28 inclusive of Upper Falls Tract, within $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ and
 $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8.
Resort and Public Camp Ground within $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, and $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$
of Section 16. All use is within T 4 S, R 27 E, MDB&M.

All rights and privileges under this license including method of diversion, method of use and quantity of water diverted are subject to the continuing authority of the Department acting through the State Engineer in accordance with law and in the interest of the public welfare to prevent waste, unreasonable use, unreasonable method of use or unreasonable method of diversion of said water.

Reports shall be filed promptly by licensee on appropriate forms which will be provided for the purpose from time to time by the State Engineer.

The right hereby confirmed to the diversion and use of water is restricted to the point or points of diversion herein specified and to the lands or place of use herein described.
