ORDER REVOKING LICENSE

SOURCE: Unnamed Stream tributary to Ramon Creek and Whitewater River
COUNTY: Riverside

WHEREAS:

1. A triennial Report of Licensee for 2002, 2003, 2004 dated March 21, 2005 has been received from Christina E. Murphey on behalf of Christina E. Murphey Trust (Licensee) requesting revocation of the license by the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights (Division).
2. The Division interprets the Licensee's request for revocation as a waiver of the notice and hearing requirements set forth in Water Code sections 1675 through 1675.2.

Therefore, it is ordered that License 5439 is hereby revoked by the State Water Board, and the water is declared to be subject to appropriation. This revocation may not result in additional water being available for new appropriations if there are applicable restrictions due to past State Water Board decisions regarding water availability.

(the date of inspection) to the satisfaction of the State Water Rights Board of a right to the use of the water of unnamed stream in Riverside County

tributary to Ramon Creek and Whitewater River

for the purpose of domestic use

under Permit 6847 of the State Water Rights Board and that said right to the use of said water has been perfected in accordance with the laws of California, the Rules and Regulations of the State Water Rights Board and the terms of the said permit; that the priority of the right herein confirmed dates from June 10, 1946 and that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to the amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed four hundred fifty (450) gallons per day to be diverted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

The point of diversion of such water is located :
South three hundred forty (340) feet and west one thousand six hundred ninety (1690) feet from $N\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 36, T5S, R5E, SBB&M, being within $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 36.

A description of the lands or the place where such water is put to beneficial use is as follows:
Within $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, T5S, R5E, SBB&M.
