ORDER ALLOWING ADDITION OF POINT OF REDIVERISION
AND CORRECTING DESCRIPTION OF PLACE OF USE

WHEREAS:

1. License 10472 was issued to Guido Venturi and Josephine Venturi and was recorded with the County Recorder of Mendocino County on April 30, 1975 in Book 997, Page 288.
2. A petition for change by addition of point of rediverison has been filed with the State Water Resources Control Board and said Board has determined that good cause for such change has been shown.
3. The Board has determined that the petitioned change does not constitute the initiation of a new right nor operate to the injury of any other lawful user of water.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The points of diversion under this license shall be as follows:

DIVERSION: North 700 feet and West 2,200 feet from SE corner of projected Section 17, T16N, R12W, MDB&M, being within SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 17.

REDIVERISION: North 1,150 feet and West 950 feet from SE corner of projected Section 17, T16N, R12W, MDB&M, being within SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 17.

2. The place of use under this license shall be as follows:
7 acres within NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of projected Section 17, T16N, R12W, MDB&M
4 acres within NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of projected Section 17, T16N, R12W, MDB&M
4.8 acres within SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of projected Section 17, T16N, R12W, MDB&M
14.2 acres within SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of projected Section 17, T16N, R12W, MDB&M
30 acres, total.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That GUIDO VENTURI AND JOSEPHINE VENTURI
P. O. BOX 45, CALPELLA, CALIFORNIA 95418

HAVE made proof as of **NOVEMBER 8, 1974** (the date of inspection)
to the satisfaction of the State Water Resources Control Board of a right to the use of the water of
AN UNNAMED STREAM IN MENDOCINO COUNTY
tributary to **WEST FORK RUSSIAN RIVER**

for the purpose of **IRRIGATION AND FROST PROTECTION USES**
under Permit **16201** of the Board and that the right to the use of this water has been perfected
in accordance with the laws of California, the Regulations of the Board and the permit terms; that the
priority of this right dates from **APRIL 27, 1970** and that the amount of water to which
this right is entitled and hereby confirmed is limited to the amount actually beneficially used for the stated
purposes and shall not exceed **TEN AND FOUR-TENTHS (10.4) ACRE-FEET PER ANNUM, TO BE**
COLLECTED FROM OCTOBER 1 OF EACH YEAR TO MAY 1 OF THE SUCCEEDING YEAR. THE
MAXIMUM WITHDRAWAL IN ANY ONE YEAR SHALL NOT EXCEED 10 ACRE-FEET.

THE POINT OF DIVERSION OF SUCH WATER IS LOCATED:

NORTH 700 FEET AND WEST 2,200 FEET FROM SE CORNER OF SECTION 17, T16N, R12W, MDB&M, BEING WITHIN SW1/4 OF SE1/4 OF SAID SECTION 17.

A DESCRIPTION OF LANDS OR THE PLACE WHERE SUCH WATER IS PUT TO BENEFICIAL USE IS AS FOLLOWS:

- 8 ACRES WITHIN NE1/4 OF SE1/4 OF SECTION 17, T16N, R12W, MDB&M**
 - 14 ACRES WITHIN SE1/4 OF SE1/4 OF SECTION 17, T16N, R12W, MDB&M**
 - 3 ACRES WITHIN NW1/4 OF SE1/4 OF SECTION 17, T16N, R12W, MDB&M**
 - 5 ACRES WITHIN SW1/4 OF SE1/4 OF SECTION 17, T16N, R12W, MDB&M**
- 30 ACRES TOTAL**


THIS LICENSE DOES NOT AUTHORIZE COLLECTION OF WATER TO STORAGE OUTSIDE OF THE SPECIFIED SEASON TO OFFSET EVAPORATION AND SEEPAGE OR FOR ANY OTHER PURPOSE.

IN ORDER TO PREVENT DEGRADATION OF THE QUALITY OF WATER, LICENSEE SHALL COMPLY WITH ANY WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS IMPOSED BY THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD, NORTH COAST REGION, OR BY THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD.

THE QUANTITY OF WATER DIVERTED UNDER THIS LICENSE IS SUBJECT TO MODIFICATION BY THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD, IF, AFTER NOTICE TO THE LICENSEE AND AN OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING, THE BOARD FINDS THAT SUCH MODIFICATION IS NECESSARY TO MEET WATER QUALITY OBJECTIVES IN WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLANS WHICH HAVE BEEN OR HEREAFTER MAY BE ESTABLISHED OR MODIFIED PURSUANT TO DIVISION 7 OF THE WATER CODE. NO ACTION WILL BE TAKEN PURSUANT TO THIS PARAGRAPH UNLESS THE BOARD FINDS THAT (1) ADEQUATE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS HAVE BEEN PRESCRIBED AND ARE IN EFFECT WITH RESPECT TO ALL WASTE DISCHARGES WHICH HAVE ANY SUBSTANTIAL EFFECT UPON WATER QUALITY IN THE AREA INVOLVED, AND (2) THE WATER QUALITY OBJECTIVES CANNOT BE ACHIEVED SOLELY THROUGH THE CONTROL OF WASTE DISCHARGES.

Licensee shall allow representatives of the Board and other parties, as may be authorized from time to time by the Board, reasonable access to project works to determine compliance with the terms of this license.

All rights and privileges under this license, including method of diversion, method of use and quantity of water diverted are subject to the continuing authority of the Board in accordance with law and in the interest of the public welfare to prevent waste, unreasonable use, unreasonable method of use or unreasonable method of diversion of said water.



Reports shall be filed promptly by licensee on appropriate forms which will be provided for the purpose from time to time by the Board.

The right hereby confirmed to the diversion and use of water is restricted to the point or points of diversion herein specified and to the lands or place of use herein described.

This license is granted and licensee accepts all rights herein confirmed subject to the following provisions of the Water Code:

Section 1625. Each license shall be in such form and contain such terms as may be prescribed by the Board.

Section 1626. All licenses shall be under the terms and conditions of this division (of the Water Code).

Section 1627. A license shall be effective for such time as the water actually appropriated under it is used for a useful and beneficial purpose in conformity with this division (of the Water Code) but no longer.

Section 1628. Every license shall include the enumeration of conditions therein which in substance shall include all of the provisions of this article and the statement that any appropriator of water to whom a license is issued takes the license subject to the conditions therein expressed.

Section 1629. Every licensee, if he accepts a license does so under the conditions precedent that no value whatsoever in excess of the actual amount paid to the State therefor shall at any time be assigned to or claimed for any license granted or issued under the provisions of this division (of the Water Code); or for any rights granted or acquired under the provisions of this division (of the Water Code); in respect to the regulation by any competent public authority of the services or the price of the services to be rendered by any licensee or by the holder of any rights granted or acquired under the provisions of this division (of the Water Code) or in respect to any valuation for purposes of sale to or purchase, whether through condemnation proceedings or otherwise, by the State or any city, city and county, municipal water district, irrigation district, lighting district, or any political subdivision of the State, of the rights and property of any licensee, or the possessor of any rights granted, issued, or acquired under the provisions of this division (of the Water Code).

Section 1630. At any time after the expiration of twenty years after the granting of a license, the State or any city, city and county, municipal water district, irrigation district, lighting district, or any political subdivision of the State shall have the right to purchase the works and property occupied and used under the license and the works built or constructed for the enjoyment of the rights granted under the license.

Section 1631. In the event that the State, or any city, city and county, municipal water district, irrigation district, lighting district, or political subdivision of the State so desiring to purchase and the owner of the works and property cannot agree upon the purchase price, the price shall be determined in such manner as is now or may hereafter be provided by law for determining the value of property taken in eminent domain proceedings.
