ORDER

APPLICATION 7478 PERMIT 4071 LICENSE _____

ORDER APPROVING A NEW DEVELOPMENT SCHEDULE,
AND AMENDING THE PERMIT

WHEREAS:

1. Permit 4071 was issued to C. T. Oeste on February 27, 1933 pursuant to Application 7478.
2. Permit 4071 was subsequently assigned to El Dorado Irrigation District.
3. A petition for an extension of time within which to develop the project and apply the water to the proposed use has been filed with the State Water Resources Control Board.
4. The permittee has proceeded with diligence and good cause has been shown for the extension of time.
5. Permit Condition 6 pertaining to the continuing authority of the Board should be updated to conform to Section 780(a), Title 23 of the California Code of Regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Condition 5 of the permit be amended to read:

COMPLETE CONSTRUCTION WORK AND
APPLICATION OF THE WATER TO THE
PROPOSED USE SHALL BE MADE
ON OR BEFORE

December 31, 1999 (000009)

2. Condition 6 of this permit be amended to read:


Pursuant to California Water Code Sections 100 and 275, and the common law public trust doctrine, all rights and privileges under this permit and under any license issued pursuant thereto, including method of diversion, method of use, and quantity of water diverted, are subject to the continuing authority of the State Water Resources Control Board in accordance with law and in the interest of the public welfare to protect public trust uses and to prevent waste, unreasonable use, unreasonable method of use, or unreasonable method of diversion of said water.

The continuing authority of the Board may be exercised by imposing specific requirements over and above those contained in this permit with a view to eliminating waste of water and to meeting the reasonable water requirements of permittee without unreasonable draft on the source. Permittee may be required to implement a water conservation plan, features of which may include but not necessarily be limited to: (1) reusing or reclaiming the water allocated; (2) using water reclaimed by another entity instead of all or part of the water allocated; (3) restricting diversions so as to eliminate agricultural tailwater or to reduce return flow; (4) suppressing evaporation losses from water surfaces;

(5) controlling phreatophytic growth; and (6) installing, maintaining, and operating efficient water measuring devices to assure compliance with the quantity limitations of this permit and to determine accurately water use as against reasonable water requirements for the authorized project. No action will be taken pursuant to this paragraph unless the Board determines, after notice to affected parties and opportunity for hearing, that such specific requirements are physically and financially feasible and are appropriate to the particular situation.

The continuing authority of the Board also may be exercised by imposing further limitations on the diversion and use of water by the permittee in order to protect public trust uses. No action will be taken pursuant to this paragraph unless the Board determines, after notice to affected parties and opportunity for hearing, that such action is consistent with California Constitution Article X, Section 2; is consistent with the public interest and is necessary to preserve or restore the uses protected by the public trust. ORDER APPROVING A NEW DEVELOPMENT SCHEDULE, AMENDING PERMIT AND CORRECTING
DESCRIPTION OF THE PURPOSE OF USE

WHEREAS:

1. A petition for extension of time within which to develop the project and apply the water to the proposed use and a petition to correct the description of the purpose of use have been filed with the State Water Resources Control Board.
2. It appears that the permittee has proceeded with diligence and that good cause has been shown for extension of time and for correcting the description of the purpose of use.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. A new development schedule is approved as follows:

CONSTRUCTION WORK SHALL BE COMPLETED ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 1988.

APPLICATION OF THE WATER TO THE PROPOSED USE SHALL BE COMPLETED ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 1988.

2. The total annual diversion and use allowed under Permit 4071 be limited to 104 acre-feet.
3. The description of the purpose of use be corrected to read as follows:

IRRIGATION AND MUNICIPAL

4. Paragraph 6 be added to the permit as follows:

Pursuant to Water Code Section 100, all rights and privileges under this permit and under any license issued pursuant thereto, including method of diversion, method of use, and quantity of water diverted, are subject to the continuing authority of the State Water Resources Control Board in accordance with law and in the interest of the public welfare to prevent waste, unreasonable use, unreasonable method of use, or unreasonable method of diversion of said water.

This continuing authority of the Board may be exercised by imposing specific requirements over and above those contained in this permit with a view to minimizing waste of water and to meeting the reasonable water requirements of permittee without unreasonable draft on the source. Permittee may be required to implement such programs as

(1) reusing or reclaiming the water allocated; (2) restricting diversions so as to eliminate agricultural tailwater or to reduce return flow; (3) suppressing evaporation losses from water surfaces; (4) controlling phreatophytic growth; and (5) installing, maintaining, and operating efficient water measuring devices to assure compliance with the quantity limitations of this permit and to determine accurately water use as against reasonable water requirements for the authorized project. No action will be taken pursuant to this paragraph unless the Board determines, after notice to affected parties and opportunity for hearing, that such specific requirements are physically and financially feasible and are appropriate to the particular situation.

5. Paragraph 7 be added to the permit as follows:

The quantity of water diverted under this permit and under any license issued pursuant thereto is subject to modification by the State Water Resources Control Board, if, after notice to the permittee and an opportunity for hearing, the Board finds that such modification is necessary to meet water quality objectives in Water Quality Control plans which have been or hereafter may be established or modified pursuant to Division 7 of the Water Code. No action will be taken pursuant to this paragraph unless the Board finds that (1) adequate waste discharge requirements have been prescribed and are in effect with respect to all waste discharges which have any substantial effect upon water quality in the area involved, and (2) the water quality objectives cannot be achieved solely through the control of waste discharges.

This is to certify that the application of which the foregoing is a true and correct copy has been considered and is hereby approved SUBJECT TO VESTED RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions in addition to those enumerated in Chapter 586, Statutes 1913, as amended.

1. The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, and shall not exceed twenty-five hundredths (0.25) cubic foot per second from about May 1st to about November 1st of each season and throughout the remainder of the year as required for domestic purposes.
In case of rotation the equivalent of such continuous flow allowance for any thirty day period may be diverted in a shorter time if there be no interference with other vested rights.

2. The maximum amount herein stated may be reduced in the license if investigation so warrants.

3. Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 1, 1933 and shall

hereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence, and if not so commenced and prosecuted this permit may be revoked.

4. Said construction work shall be completed on or before ~~December 1, 1933~~ *December 1, 1935*

5. Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before ~~December 1, 1933~~ *December 1, 1936*
