### **Title Page (Table 1, last line)**

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) and the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board have classified this discharge as a ~~minor~~ major discharge.

### **Provision IV.C.1.d. (page 9)**

If the Discharger can demonstrate that toxicity exceeding the levels cited above is caused by ammonia and that the ammonia in the ~~discharger~~ discharge complies with ammonia effluent limits, then such toxicity does not constitute a violation of this effluent limitation.
